

Construction Update SR 981, SECTION Q20

2022 Construction Activity:

Work will begin on the Route 981/Route 819 roundabout and the new realigned Route 981 between Hecla Road/State Street and the PA Turnpike. Construction crews will also begin excavation for the new Route 981 alignment between Carpentertown Road and Walton's Lane.

Section Q20 is the first of three Laurel Valley Transportation Improvement Projects (LVTIP) to advance to construction. The project will improve 4.5 miles from the Route 981/Route 819 intersection to the Route 981/Route 2023 (Holly Place Road) intersection near Norvelt.

Construction will include:

- Sight distance improvements
- Improvements to curves and grades
- Consistent 12-foot travel lanes throughout
- Eight-foot-wide shoulders to accomodate bicycles, pedestrians

Project construction began in December 2021, including:

- Clearing land for the new alignment and widening areas
- Placing erosion and sedimentation controls

UNIQUE PROJECT — FEATURES

- Three Roundabouts
- Partnership with Mt. Pleasant School District for roundabout gateway treatment
- Partnership with Mt. Pleasant Township for drainage and stormwater improvements
- Removal of unused railroad tressle

SR 981, Section Q20 Roundabouts

Roundabouts are becoming more common due to advantages of increased safety and reduced delay. Single-lane roundabouts will be built at three locations:

- Routes 981/819 (shown at right)
- Route 981/State St./Hecla Road
- Norvelt intersection

Roundabouts improve safety with fewer conflict points and encourage lower speeds. They can carry 30% more vehicles than similarly-sized signalized intersections during peak traffic conditions, due to more free flowing traffic, using yields instead of stop signs.


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2022 CONSTRUCTION & DETOURS

Two detours are anticipated during the 2022 construction season. Additional short-term, periodic detours may occur as needed. Check the project website and sign up for email updates tor the most current construction updates.



Additional work, highlighted in orange in the map above, will be underway throughout the year with limited traffic impacts. Excavation work will begin for the 1.75-mile new alignment north of the PA Turnpike and will include relocation of Carpentertown Road and the construction of a new Route 981/Boyer Road intersection. A new bridge will be constructed over Boyer Run.



DETOUR Route 819 Southern Approach

Timing Late Summer 2022

Purpose


Prepare for construction of the Route 819 Roundabout with sanitary sewer work and construction of the box culvert carrying Shupe Run under the new roadway

Closure

Route 819 closed at the southern approach to the intersection

Detour Route

- Passenger vehicles will use State Street and Route 981.
- Larger vehicles will use Routes 31 and 119.



Note: Temporary signals will be installed in this area in early summer when Route 981 will be reduced to a single lane.

DETOUR Route 981/Fiedors Grove Road

Timing

Late Summer 2022, 10-day duration

Purpose

Construction of new Route 981 alignment from Hecla Road to just north of the PA Turnpike.

Closure

Route 981 near Fiedors Grove Road and PA Turnpike Bridge

Detour Route

- Fiedors Grove Road traffic will use Viking Drive and State Street.
- Route 981 Traffic will use Route 819, Route 31, Route 981, and Kecksburg Road.

WORK ZONE SAFETY Drive carefully for your safety and the safety of highway workers.

- Drive the posted work zone speed limit.
- Stay alert and pay close attention to signs and flaggers.
- Turn on your headlights if signs instruct you to do so.
- Maintain a safe distance around vehicles. Don't tailgate.
- Stay in Touch with the Project Team


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- Use four-way flashers when stopped or traveling slowly.
